TREE REMOVAL

ACTIVITY	HAZARDS	RISK CONTROL MEASURES	RESPONSIBLE
Tree Felling	Falling branches	Establish a public no-go zone around area where objects could fall. When working under tree wear hard hat.	Contractor
Tree Felling Working at Heights	Falling from tree.	Use a licensed tree-felling contractor with appropriate insurance. Do not use a ladder to ascend above 2m. Use a cherry picker or scaffold above 2m.	Contractor
Tree Felling Using Chainsaw.	Damage to limbs. Noise damage. Cuts and sprains	Ensure persons using equipment have been trained and are experienced in its use and have appropriate certificates and insurance. Wear appropriate PPE.	Contractor
Chipping branches	Damage to limbs. Noise damage. Cuts and sprains	Ensure persons using equipment have been trained and are experienced in its use and have appropriate certificates and insurance. Wear appropriate PPE.	Contractor
Removing material / Setting up	Moving vehicles	Ensure path is clear and that at least one person is directing form outside vehicle in plain view of driver.	Contractor
